Our dedicated team worked tirelessly to craft this bill because we recognized the importance of protecting our children's future. This legislation represents a resolute commitment to family values and parental autonomy. Concerned parents played a significant role in bringing the issues this bill covers to the forefront. During my

discussions with West Virginians, it became apparent to me that the issue of parental rights was on everyone's mind.

Where we are

The bill has been submitted to Delegate Scot Heckert for legislative formatting by his bill writer and is currently being socialized with many representatives in the House and the Senate expressing support.

We urged Governor Jim Justice to add this bill to a Special Session prior to school starting but were unsuccessful in getting him to move on it. However, we did lobby the West Virginia legislation during their interim session to get their support. We believe we have the votes in the house and there are four senators that have offered to be lead sponsor.


On the Road
