Capital Punishments for Human Traffickers

This has led to the number of people living in slavery today to be estimated at three times the number that existed at the height of the transatlantic slave trade (UN’s International Labor Organization (ILO)). According to *Forced labour,*

modern slavery and human trafficking on the ILO website, 49.6 million people were living in modern slavery in 2021, of which 4.9 million are women and girls and a startling 12% of the 49.6 million were children.¹

It's a finding Defense Department researchers say should call attention to the condition, known as myocarditis, as a potential side effect of the immunizations.

In another article published in *JAMA Cardiology*, U.S. Army, Navy and Air Force physicians described 23 cases of myocarditis in previously healthy males who developed the condition within four days of receiving a COVID-19 vaccine.²

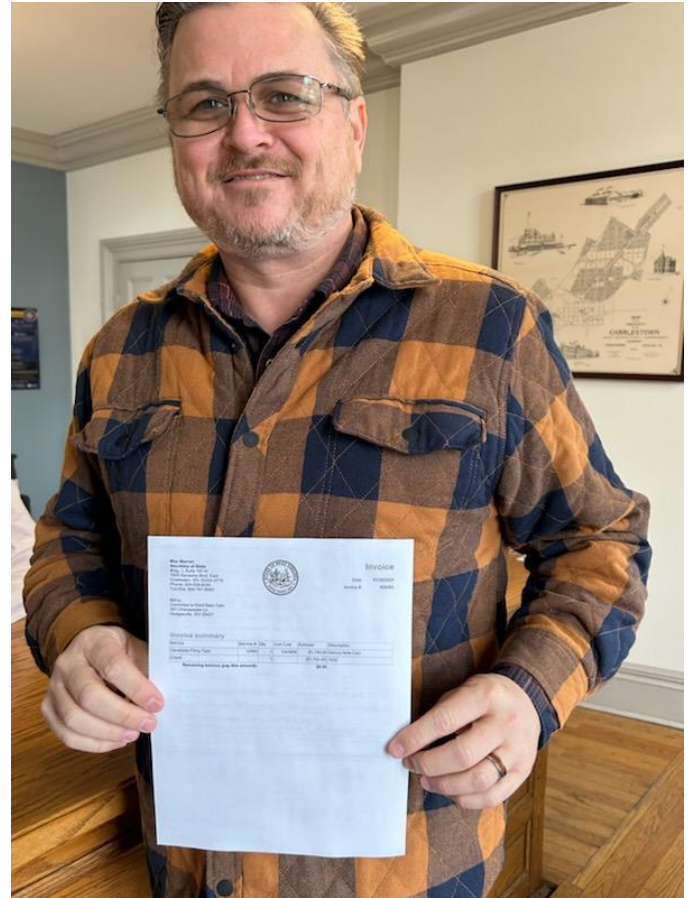


Figure 4 It's Official
